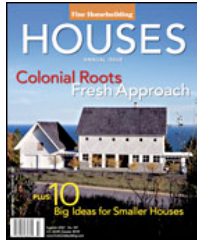

Specialty Suspended Seating

Installation Tip

Raise the frame to be flush with cabinet and counter-top

The snack bar frame should be raised (using the carriage bolts) so the top of the frame is flush with the top of the cabinet or underside of the counter-top.

If the counter-top is designed with a bull-nose feature, the suspended seating frame should be lowered enough to clear the drop of the bull-nose. Please use care to not drop the frame too far, thus compromising the positioning of the chair height.
